

Cookies Policy

1. What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file which is sent to the browser from a website that the user visits. It helps the website store information pertaining to his visit, such as the preferred language and other settings. This can facilitate his next visit and make the website more useful for him. Cookies play an important role. Without them, the use of the web would be a much more complicated experience.

2. Why do we use cookies?

Cookies are used for multiple reasons. They are used for example, for saving the user preferences regarding the safe search, in order to calculate the number of visitors in a page or so as to facilitate the user in registering to services and so as to protect his data.

3. Functionality and content of the website

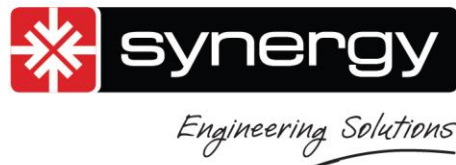
The functionality of common users' use is used by the visitors in order to introduce websites and its contents to social networks such as Facebook. Cookies store information relative to the way visitors use the functionality of common use – although not on a personal level – in order to improve the website. If you do not accept cookies, no information is being stored. For some of the functionalities of our website, we may use third party providers, for example when you visit a web page with embedded photos, video or links to YouTube. Those videos or links (and any other content from third party providers) may contain cookies of the third parties and you can consult the policies of the third parties' websites for information regarding their use of cookies.

4. How can I reject and delete the cookies?

We will not use the cookies for the collection of users' personal data, except with their explicit consent. Nevertheless, you can choose to reject or block cookies by changing the browser settings – for more details, refer to the "Help" function of the browser. Please note that most browsers accept automatically the cookies therefore, if you do not want cookies to be used, you may need to actively delete or block the cookies. For information regarding the use of cookies in browsers for mobile phones, as well as for details pertaining to the procedure for rejecting or deleting such cookies, please go to the browser settings. Please note however, that if you reject the use of cookies, you will be able to visit our websites, but some functionalities may not work properly.
